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## LETTER FROM THE BOARD

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### 1. INTRODUCTION

The purpose of this circular is to provide the Shareholders with information in respect of certain resolutions to be proposed at the 2026 AGM for (i) the granting of the Repurchase Mandate to the Directors; (ii) the granting of the Issuance Mandate to the Directors; (iii) the extension of the Issuance Mandate by adding to it the aggregate number of Shares repurchased by the Company under the Repurchase Mandate; and (iv) the re-election of the retiring Directors.

### 2. PROPOSED GRANTING OF THE REPURCHASE AND ISSUANCE MANDATES

At the annual general meeting of the Company held on June 10, 2025, general mandates were granted to the Directors to exercise the powers of the Company to repurchase Shares and to issue new Shares. Such mandates, to the extent not utilized, will lapse at the conclusion of the 2026 AGM.

Ordinary resolutions will be proposed at the 2026 AGM to approve the granting of new general mandates to the Directors:

- (a) to purchase Shares, on the Stock Exchange or on any other stock exchange recognized by the Securities and Futures Commission of Hong Kong and the Stock Exchange, not exceeding 10% of the total number of issued Shares (excluding treasury Shares) as at the date of passing of such resolution (i.e. 147,358,909 Shares on the basis that the existing issued share capital of the Company of 1,473,589,098 Shares remains unchanged as at the date of the 2026 AGM) (the “**Repurchase Mandate**”);
- (b) to allot, issue or deal with additional Shares (including any sale or transfer of treasury Shares) not exceeding 20% of the total number of issued Shares (excluding treasury Shares) as at the date of passing of such resolution (i.e. 294,717,819 Shares on the basis that the existing issued share capital of the Company of 1,473,589,098 Shares remains unchanged as at the date of the 2026 AGM) (the “**Issuance Mandate**”); and
- (c) to extend the Issuance Mandate by an amount representing the number of Shares repurchased by the Company pursuant to and in accordance with the Repurchase Mandate.

The Repurchase Mandate and the Issuance Mandate will continue in force until the conclusion of the next annual general meeting of the Company held after the 2026 AGM or any earlier date as referred to in the proposed ordinary resolutions contained in items 7 and 8 of the notice of the 2026 AGM as set out on pages AGM-1 to AGM-5 of this circular.

In accordance with the requirements of the Listing Rules, the Company is required to send to the Shareholders an explanatory statement containing all the information reasonably necessary to enable them to make an informed decision on whether to vote for or against the granting of the Repurchase Mandate. The explanatory statement as required by the Listing Rules in connection with the Repurchase Mandate is set out in Appendix I to this circular.

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### 3. PROPOSED RE-ELECTION OF THE RETIRING DIRECTORS

Pursuant to Article 108 of the Articles of Association, Ms. Yue'e Zhang and Mr. Chen Geng shall retire at the 2026 AGM. Both of the above two retiring Directors, being eligible, will offer themselves for re-election at the 2026 AGM.

The nomination committee of the Company has reviewed the structure and composition of the Board, the confirmations and disclosures given by the Directors, the qualifications, skills and experience, time commitment and contribution of the retiring Directors with reference to the nomination principles and criteria set out in the Company's Board diversity policy and director nomination policy, and the independence of all independent non-executive Directors.

Mr. Chen Geng, who has been serving as an independent non-executive Director for more than 9 years and his re-election as an independent non-executive Director will therefore be subject to a separate resolution to be approved by the Shareholders at the 2026 AGM. Mr. Chen demonstrates the ability to provide an independent, balanced and objective view to the Company's matters. As disclosed in the corporate governance reports of the Company, Mr. Chen Geng attended all the meetings of the Board and Board committees, and general meetings of the Company held in the previous and current financial years. Mr. Chen has always remained responsible in performance of his functions and discharge of his duties to the Company through active participation and discussions, bringing balance of views as well as knowledge, experience and expertise to the Board.

The Company has received annual confirmation from Mr. Chen on his independence with reference to the independence guidelines set out in Rule 3.13 of the Listing Rules. In assessing the independence of Mr. Chen, the nomination committee of the Company noted that Mr. Chen (i) does not have any relationship with any Directors, senior management or substantial shareholders or controlling shareholders of the Company; (ii) is not involved in any relationships or circumstances which would interfere with the exercise of his independent judgment as an independent non-executive Director; and (iii) has obtained in-depth understanding of the Group's operation and business and has been providing objective and independent views to the Company during his tenure of office.

The nomination committee of the Company and the Board thus considered that the retiring independent non-executive Director is independent in accordance with the independence guidelines set out in the Listing Rules. Besides, the nomination committee of the Company and the Board believed that the extensive business experience of Ms. Zhang and Mr. Chen will continue to make contribution to the Board and are satisfied with all the retiring Directors' contribution to the Company, which will continue to bring valuable business experience, knowledge and professionalism to the Board for its efficient and effective functioning and diversity. The nomination committee of the Company and the Board therefore recommended the re-election of all the retiring Directors, including the aforesaid independent non-executive Director, who are due to retire at the 2026 AGM.

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Pursuant to Rule 13.74 of the Listing Rules, a listed issuer shall disclose the details required under Rule 13.51(2) of the Listing Rules of any director(s) proposed to be re-elected or proposed new director in the notice or accompanying circular to its shareholders of the relevant general meeting, if such re-election or appointment is subject to shareholders' approval at that relevant general meeting. The requisite details of the above two retiring Directors are set out in Appendix II to this circular.

#### 4. 2026 AGM AND PROXY ARRANGEMENT

The notice of the 2026 AGM is set out on pages AGM-1 to AGM-5 of this circular. At the 2026 AGM, resolutions will be proposed to approve, *inter alia*, the granting of the Repurchase Mandate and the Issuance Mandate, the extension of the Issuance Mandate by the addition thereto of the number of Shares repurchased pursuant to the Repurchase Mandate and the re-election of the retiring Directors.

Pursuant to Rule 13.39(4) of the Listing Rules, any vote of shareholders at a general meeting must be taken by poll. Accordingly, all the proposed resolutions will be put to vote by way of poll at the 2026 AGM. An announcement on the poll vote results will be published by the Company after the 2026 AGM in the manner prescribed under Rule 13.39(5) of the Listing Rules.

*The following is an explanatory statement required by the Listing Rules to be sent to the Shareholders to enable them to make an informed decision on whether to vote for or against the ordinary resolution to be proposed at the 2026 AGM in relation to the granting of the Repurchase Mandate.*

## **1. REASONS FOR REPURCHASES OF SHARES**

The Directors believe that the granting of the Repurchase Mandate is in the interests of the Company and the Shareholders.

Repurchases of Shares may, depending on the market conditions and funding arrangements at the time, lead to an enhancement of the net asset value per Share and/or earnings per Share. The Directors are seeking the granting of the Repurchase Mandate to give the Company the flexibility to do so if and when appropriate. The number of Shares to be repurchased on any occasion and the price and other terms upon which the same are repurchased will be decided by the Directors at the relevant time, having regard to the circumstances then pertaining.

## **2. SHARE CAPITAL**

As at the Latest Practicable Date, the issued share capital of the Company comprised 1,473,589,098 Shares.

Subject to the passing of the ordinary resolution set out in item 7 of the notice of the 2026 AGM in respect of the granting of the Repurchase Mandate and on the basis that the issued ordinary share capital of the Company remains unchanged as at the date of the 2026 AGM, i.e. being 1,473,589,098 Shares, the Directors would be authorized under the Repurchase Mandate to repurchase, during the period in which the Repurchase Mandate remains in force, a maximum of 147,358,909 Shares, representing 10% of the total number of Shares in issue (excluding treasury Shares) as at the date of the 2026 AGM.

## **3. FUNDING OF REPURCHASES**

Repurchases of Shares will be funded from the Company's internal resources, which shall be funds legally available for such purposes in accordance with the Company's Memorandum and Articles of Association, the Listing Rules, the laws of the Cayman Islands and/or any other applicable laws, as the case may be.

## **4. IMPACT OF REPURCHASES**

There might be a material adverse impact on the working capital or gearing position of the Company (as compared with the position disclosed in the audited accounts contained in the annual report of the Company for the year ended December 31, 2025) in the event that the Repurchase Mandate was to be carried out in full at any time during the proposed repurchase period. However, the Directors do not intend to exercise the Repurchase Mandate to such an extent as would, in the

circumstances, have a material adverse effect on the working capital requirements of the Company or the gearing levels which in the opinion of the Directors are from time to time befitting the Company.

## 5. TAKEOVERS CODE

If, on the exercise of the power to repurchase Shares pursuant to the Repurchase Mandate, a Shareholder's proportionate interest in the voting rights of the Company increases, such increase will be treated as an acquisition for the purposes of the Takeovers Code. Accordingly, a Shareholder, or a group of Shareholders acting in concert, could obtain or consolidate control of the Company and become obliged to make a mandatory offer in accordance with Rule 26 of the Takeovers Code for all the Shares not already owned by such Shareholder or group of Shareholders.

As at the Latest Practicable Date, Cross Mark Limited (wholly owned by Ms. Yufeng Liu) and Mr. Marc Chan (through Right Faith Holdings Limited and Amplewood Resources Limited, which are wholly owned by him) were interested in 575,061,863 and 414,025,962 issued Shares respectively, representing approximately 39.02% and 28.10% of the total issued share capital of the Company (being 1,473,589,098 Shares) respectively. On the basis that (i) the total issued share capital of the Company (being 1,473,589,098 Shares) remains unchanged as at the date of the 2026 AGM, and (ii) the shareholding interests of Cross Mark Limited and Mr. Marc Chan in the Company remain unchanged immediately after the full exercise of the Repurchase Mandate, in the event that the Directors exercise in full the power to repurchase Shares in accordance with the terms of the relevant ordinary resolution to be proposed at the 2026 AGM (presuming that apart from the decrease of the issued share capital arising from the said full exercise of the Repurchase Mandate, there is no other change in the Company's issued share capital), the shareholding interests of Cross Mark Limited and Mr. Marc Chan in the issued Shares would be increased to approximately 43.36% and 31.22% of the total issued share capital of the Company respectively. In the opinion of the Directors, the abovementioned increase of shareholdings may give rise to an obligation for Cross Mark Limited and Mr. Marc Chan to make a mandatory offer under Rule 26 of the Takeovers Code.

Save as disclosed above, the Directors are not aware of any Shareholder or group of Shareholders acting in concert, who may become obliged to make a mandatory offer in accordance with Rule 26 of the Takeovers Code as a consequence of any purchases pursuant to the Repurchase Mandate.

In addition, the Listing Rules prohibit a company from making repurchase of its shares on the Stock Exchange if the result of the repurchase would be that less than 25% (or such other prescribed minimum percentage as determined by the Stock Exchange) of the company's issued share capital would be in public hands. The Directors do not propose to repurchase Shares, which would result in less than the prescribed minimum percentage of Shares in public hands.

## 6. GENERAL

None of the Directors or, to the best of their knowledge having made all reasonable enquiries, any of their respective close associates (as defined in the Listing Rules) have any present intention to sell any Shares to the Company in the event that the granting of the Repurchase Mandate is approved by the Shareholders.

The Company has not been notified by any core connected persons (as defined in the Listing Rules) of the Company that they have a present intention to sell any Shares to the Company, or that they have undertaken not to sell any Shares held by them to the Company in the event that the granting of the Repurchase Mandate is approved by the Shareholders.

The Directors will exercise the power of the Company to make repurchases of Shares pursuant to the Repurchase Mandate in accordance with the Listing Rules and the applicable laws of the Cayman Islands. In addition, neither this explanatory statement nor the proposed share repurchases has any unusual features.
